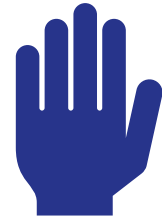

- The consultation ended on Friday and we're now collating and reviewing the feedback



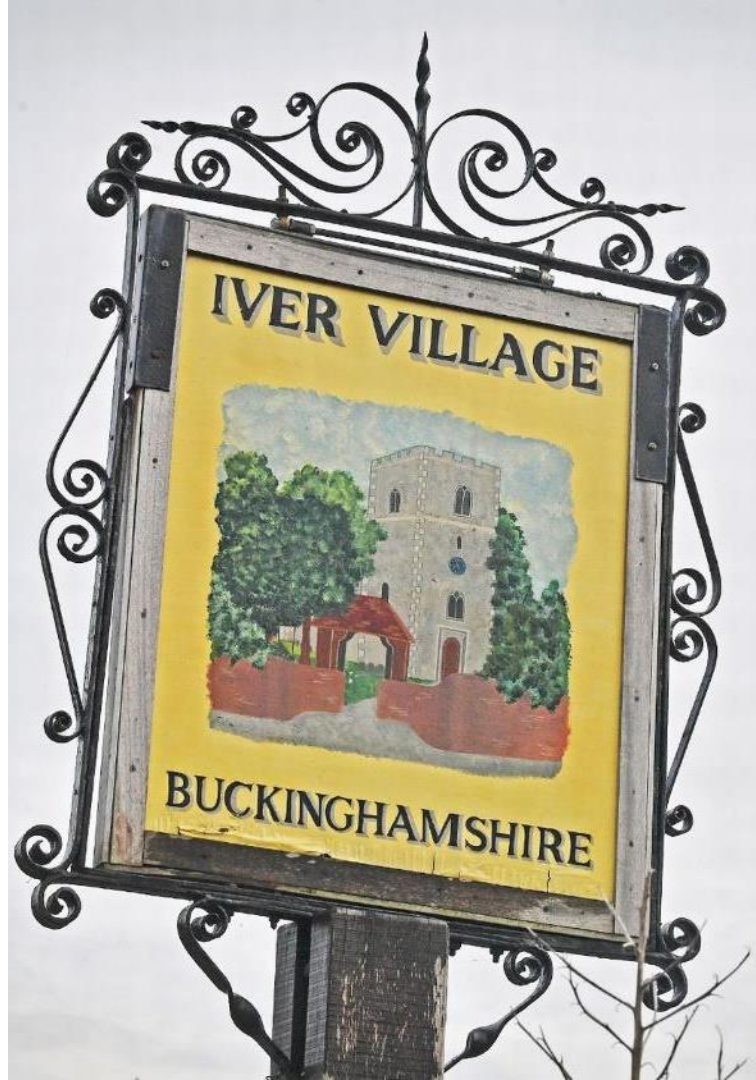
Lands and planning updates

- We now have a preferred access route, responding to the strength of views expressed by key stakeholders during the consultation
- Our proactive conversations with lands parties are progressing well to ensure the surveys can be completed in line with the project programme
- This means the relevant surveys are now almost complete.
- Discussions with the landowners are ongoing but remain constructive.
