Representations should be submitted to the Listing Review Officer at DCMS, either by email at review.requests@DCMS.gov.uk or by post at Heritage Protection Branch, Culture Team, Department for Culture, Media and Sport, 4th Floor, 100 Parliament Street, London, SW1A 2BQ.

Following the 28 day period and once any representations have been considered by DCMS, the Secretary of State will reach a decision on the application for a COI.
