MegaVolt Ampere (MVA) super grid transformers, gantries, office  
block, contractor compound, diesel generator, internal access roads,  
parking, drainage, lighting and cctv, permanent access road, bridge  
crossing, landscaping and biodiversity enhancement, and fencing.

When you email to register to speak, please include the following information:

- Your name, email address and daytime phone number
- Which of the above categories you are registering in
- Whether someone is speaking on your behalf

If more than one person has registered to speak in a category, speakers will be encouraged to coordinate with each other so that repetition can be avoided. You will be encouraged to nominate a single speaker or failing that agree to divide the time between yourselves. Where this is not possible speakers will be taken in the order of registering an intention to speak until the total time of three minutes has elapsed. Alternatively, you may ask someone to speak for you, or you may use a professional advisor.

The committee chairman may allow additional speaking time, but this will be at their discretion.
