IHRA is the main co-ordinator of this particular Parish-wide initiative and event.

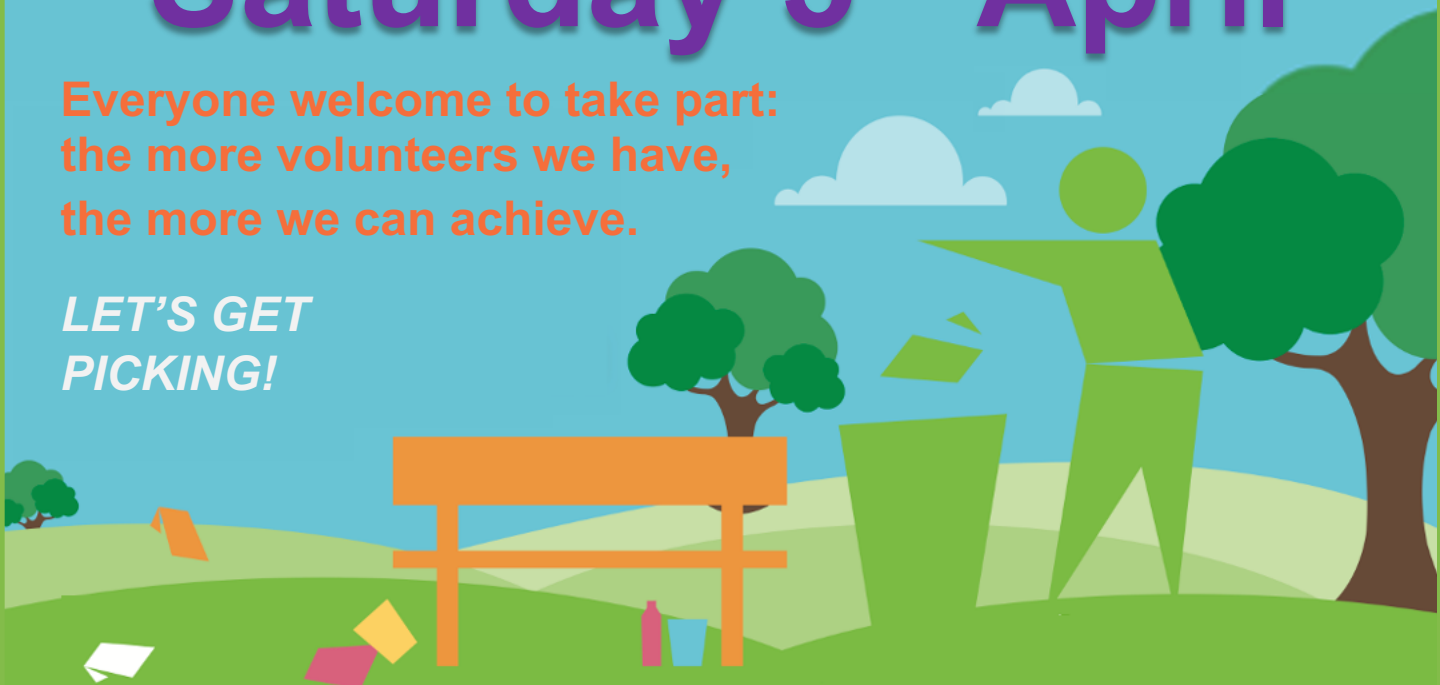

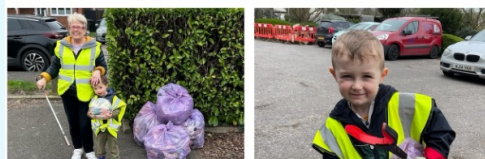
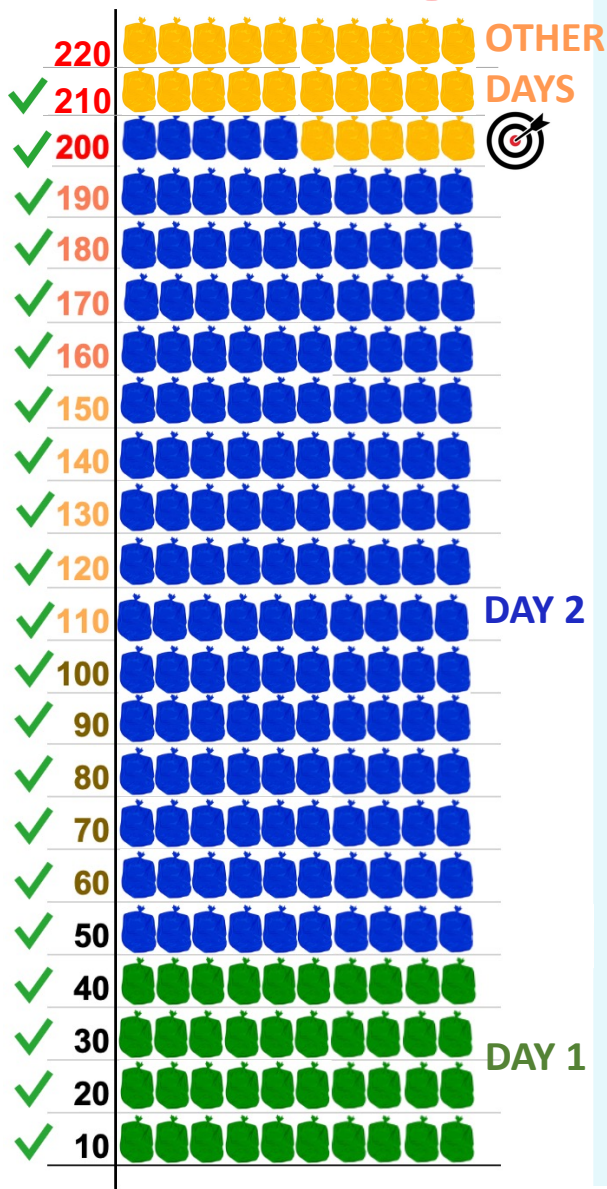
